
## Yorkshire & Humberside employers to ramp up hiring

The year will end on a high for job seekers in Yorkshire and Humberside, as employers plan to recruit at levels not seen for over a decade. The year-end hiring Outlook of +11% has not been bettered since 2007 and is significantly above the national average of +4%.

## MARKET OVERVIEW
