



Scotland is faring well amid Brexit concerns

The moderate hiring pace is expected to continue in the next three months, with employers reporting a Net Employment Outlook of +6%. Hiring prospects remain relatively stable quarter-over-quarter, and improve by four percentage points when compared with this time one year ago.

The labour market remains strong across the central belt of Scotland. There is continued demand for Drivers and Engineers across all regions. All of Scotland is facing skills shortages with particular scarcity amongst HGV Drivers. Generally, Scotland is faring well amid Brexit concerns with little change over the last nine months. Aberdeen and Dundee are the regions to watch with improved growth.
