IT employers in the UK anticipate Net Employment Outlook of +43%



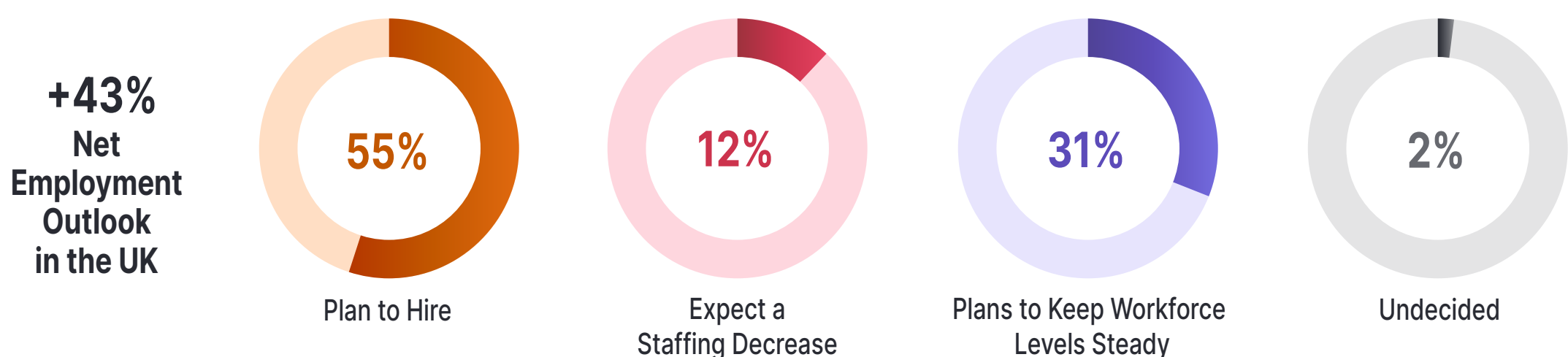
81% of IT organisations in the UK report difficulty filling open roles



Top IT staffing priorities for British employers are Cybersecurity, Customer or User Experience and Technical Support

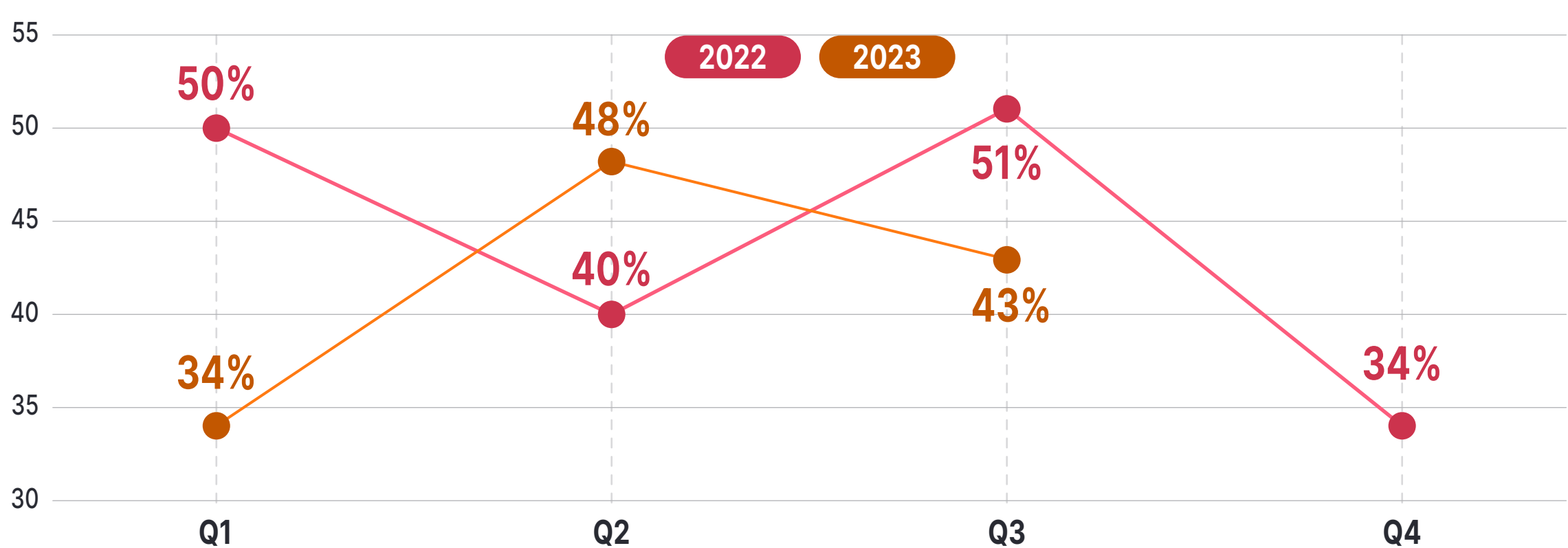
The UK IT Industry Employment Outlook

Used internationally as a bellwether of economic and labor market trends, the Net Employment Outlook – calculated by subtracting the percentage of employers who anticipate reductions to staffing levels from those who plan to hire – now stands at +43%.



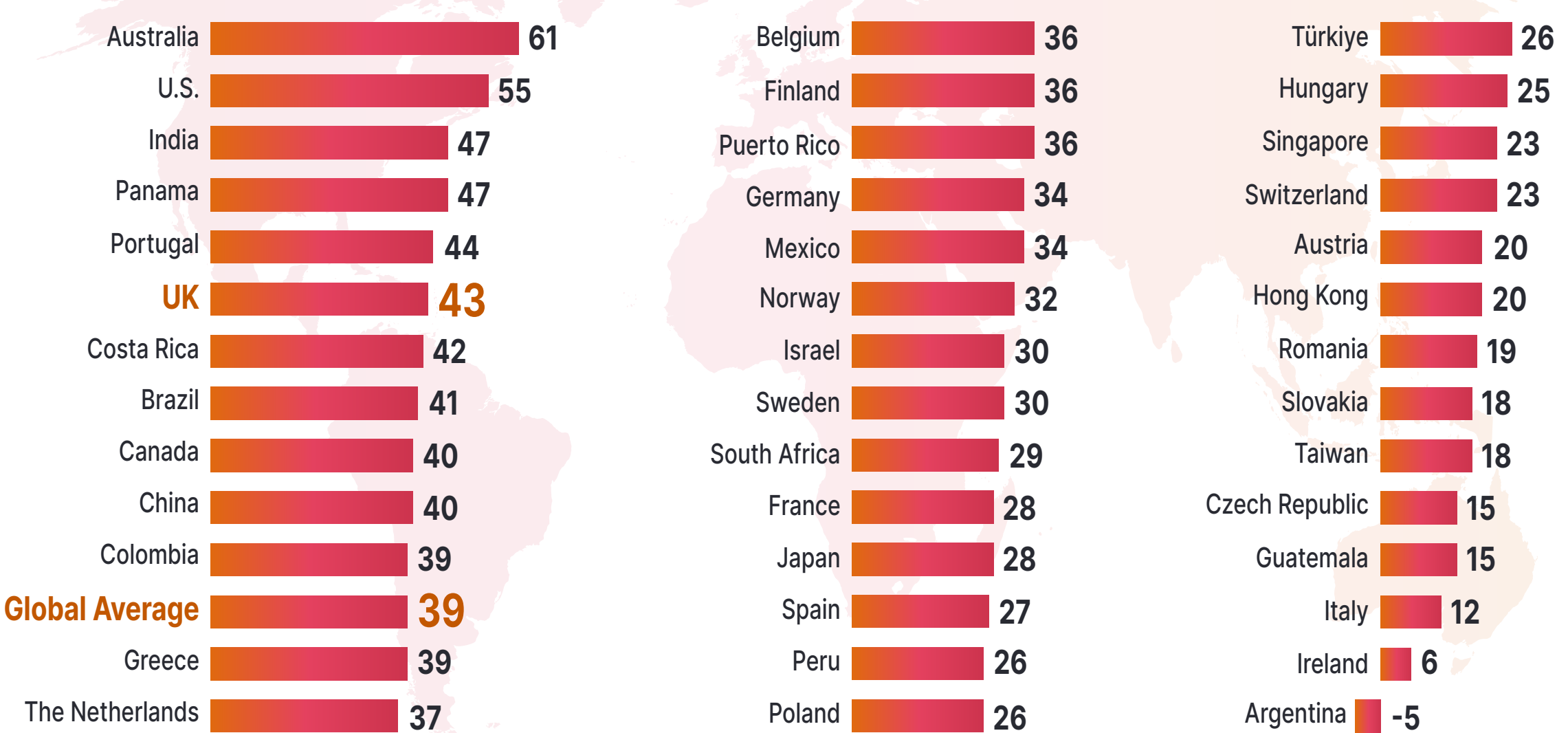
Changes Over Time

IT employers' demand across the UK has weakened by -5% since last quarter and has eased -8% when compared to this time last year.

Of the 41 countries, IT employers in Australia, the U.S., India, and Panama are driving the demand for talent in Q3.



The IT Industry's Priority Staffing Needs

Top 5 Staffing Priorities:

- 1 | Cybersecurity, 36%
- 2 | Customer or User Experience, 33%
- 3 | Technical Support, 33%
- 4 | Database Management, 29%
- 5 | Customer Relationship Management Systems, 25%

Top 5 Approaches to Address Tech Challenges:

- 1 | Invest more in Automation, 53%
- 2 | Train & Upskill Current Workforce, 53%
- 3 | Hire New Workers with the Required Skills, 50%
- 4 | Reskill Workers and Move into IT Roles, 50%
- 5 | Hire Short-term Staff (freelancers, contract workers, etc.) to Fill Any Skills Gaps, 47%
